## TRADE MARK FILING REQUIREMENTS

### MINIMUM FILING REQUIREMENTS FOR URGENT CASES

- > full name and address of the applicant(s) including state of incorporation (where applicable);
- > the exact mark;
- > the goods and/or services for which registration is sought;
- > whether any Convention priority is to be claimed and, if so, particulars of the priority application.

### PREFERRED DOCUMENTS

- > as above plus a good quality print of any stylised/device mark;
- > user information (eg proposed use or actual use in New Zealand at the date of application);
- > a copy of any priority application and (if applicable) a verified English translation.

### NOTE

- > Multi-class applications are permitted.
- > The International Classification is followed.
- > No forms signed by the applicant are required.
- > Applications are examined automatically, without further action on the part of the applicant. There is currently a delay of less than one month between lodgement and commencement of examination.
